79.48 Intersect W. bdy. of Tp.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground, to bedrock, with a granite stone 9x6x5 ins., marked X deposited at base, and in a mound of stone to top, for closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18, with brass cap marked
