

## SUBDIVISION OF T. 32 N., R. 69 E.

Chains 43.00	Draw, drains NE.
79.96	The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8.  Land, rolling. Soil, decomposed granite and limestone, 2nd and 3rd rate. Timber, none; undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and rabbit brush.
40.00	S. 89° 59' W., on a random line, bet. secs. 6 and 7.  Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
79.76	Intersect the W. bdy. of the Tp., 9 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12; an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 21 ins. above the ground, and in a mound of stone to top, mkd. and witnessed, as described in the field notes of the survey of the E. bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 68 E.  Thence S. 89° 57' E., on true line, bet. secs. 6 and 7.  Asc. 220 ft. over rolling mountainous land, on a SW. slope, thru scattering timber and undergrowth.
13.00	Spur, slopes S. 15° E.; desc. 460 ft. over a SE. slope.
37.00	Continue the descent over an E. slope.
39.76	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.  S6 $\frac{1}{4}$ ——— S7 1938  of stone, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 3 ft. high, N. of cor. raise a mound
45.00	Draw, drains S. 70° E., continue to desc. 20 ft. over an E. slope.
51.00	Road, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.
52.20	Draw, (same as at 45.00 chs.) drains N. 75° E.; continue to desc. 110 ft. over an E. slope.
79.76	The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8.  Land, rolling mountainous. Soil, rocky decomposed granite and limestone, 3rd rate. Timber, pine and juniper; undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and rabbit brush.
40.00	N. 0° 10' E., on a random line, bet. secs. 5 and 6.  Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.13	Intersect the N. bdy. of the Tp. at the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, hereinbefore described.  Thence S. 0° 10' W., on true line, bet. secs. 5 and 6.
