

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE
UTAH-NEVADA STATE LINE

Chains

N.0°18'E., on true line, along Nevada-Utah State line, on 46th mile.

Over level salt flat.

37.85 A Coast and Geodetic Survey bench mark, a bronze tablet, 4 ins. diam., set in a concrete post, 12x12x12 ins. above ground, mkd. H 77, bears East 26 lks. dist.

79.94 Proportionate point.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for the 45th mile cor., with brass cap mkd.

Land, level salt flat.

Soil, alkaline adobe, untillable.

No timber; undergrowth, sparse sagebrush.

Over level salt flat.

67.65 A point 1 lk. W. of the closing cor. of Tps. 1 and 2 S., R. 19 W., Utah; a pine post, 4 ins. sq., 12 ins. above ground, and mkd. as described in the official record.

79.94 The 44th mile cor., at which is found evidence of broken glass deposit, 6 ins. below the ground. I accept this as the original corner.

At true point for cor.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for the 44th mile cor., with brass cap mkd.

WEST BOUNDARY OF T. 32 N., R. 70 E.

The cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 N., Rs. 69 and 70 E., is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., 10 ins. above ground, mkd. and witnessed as described in the notes of T. 31 N., R. 69 E., this group.

North, with the establishment of the range line, in T. 32 N., bet. Rs. 69 and 70 E., bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over nearly level land.

2.80 Road, bears N.65°W., and S.65°E.
