FINAL TEST OF SOLAR ATTACHMENTS

September 27, 1937: At my camp, described on page 1, these notes at 7h 00m. a.m., app. t., I set off 40°44'30" N. on the lat. arcs; 1°34' S. on the decl. arcs; and orient the instruments with the solars; their lines of sight agree with the meridian established by Polaris observation.

At 4h 00m p.m. app. t., I set off 40°44'30"N. on the lat. arcs; 1°43' S. on the decl. arcs; and repeat the test of the solars; their lines of sight agree with the meridian established by Polaris observation.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Fractional township 32 north, range 70 east, is situated about 5 miles south of Wendover, Nevada; it is longitudinally terminated by the Nevada-Utah state boundary.

The land is flat, with short stretches of higher land appearing in secs. 17, 18, 20 and 21; the original bed of a salt lake.

The soil is untillable, an alkaline adobe, 4th rate, upon a volcanic rock, at a depth greater than 3 feet. It remains in a salt water soaked condition throughout the year.

There is no timber; the undergrowth consists of sagebrush and greasewood.

This township is unfit for either agriculture or grazing, and contains no evidence of mineralization.

There are no settlers within the township.
