S. 89° 56' W., on true line bet. secs. 2 and 11.

Asc. 220 ft. over rolling mountainous land, along a N. slope, thru scattering timber and undergrowth.

8.30 Road, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.

13.00 Slope, changes to E. slope, continue ascending.

26.90 Top of ascent, bears N. and S.; desc. 50 ft. over a NW. slope.

35.00 Draw, drains NE.; asc. 60 ft. abruptly.

39.00 Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 20 ft. over a NW. slope.

39.93 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Soil, rocky clay; 3d rate.

Timber, pine, juniper, and mahogany; undergrowth, sagebrush, and native weeds and grasses.

Grazing, fair.

N. 0° 13' W., on a random line bet. secs. 2 and 3.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

80.32 Intersect the N. bdy. of the Tp., 5 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35; an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 7 ins. above ground, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the survey of T. 32 N., R. 68 E.

Thence

S. 0° 15' E., on true line bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Desc. 60 ft. over rolling land, on a SE. slope, thru scattering timber and undergrowth.

.50 Draw, drains NE.; over broken land.

15.10 Draw, drains N. 75° E.; asc. 80 ft. over a N. slope.

20.80 Spur, slopes S. 80° E., for 8 chs., thence NE.; desc. 110 ft. over a SW. slope.
