A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.  $12\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 44 lks. dist.,  
mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S5 BT.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.  $2\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 71 lks. dist.,  
mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S8 BT.

75.10 Drain, course NW.; asc. slightly along a N. slope.

80.20 The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.

Land, rough mountainous.  
Soil, rocky clay, 2nd and 4th rate.  
Timber, juniper, Douglas fir, mahogany and pinon pine; undergrowth,  
sagebrush and shadscale.  
Grazing, good.

West, on true line bet. secs. 6 and 7.

Desc. 170 ft. over rolling mountainous land, along a N. slope, thru  
scattering timber and undergrowth.


18.20 Drain, course N.; desc. slightly along a N. slope.

21.80 Leave N. slope; desc. 170 ft. over a NW. slope.

31.30 Drain, course NW.; desc. 660 ft. over a NW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground,  
for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



A juniper, 4 ins. diam., bears N.  $18\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 282 lks. dist.,  
mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S6 BT.

48.20 Intersect the W. bdy. of the Tp.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground,  
for the closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7, with brass cap mkd.



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raise a mound

of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, E. of cor.

From this point, the cor. of secs. 1 and 12, T. 31 N., R. 67 E.,  
bears N.  $0^{\circ} 11'$  E., 15.47 chs. dist.

Land, rolling and rolling mountainous.  
Soil, gravelly and rocky clay; 3d rate.  
Timber, juniper and pinon pine; undergrowth, sagebrush and shadscale.  
Grazing, fair.
