## SURVEY OF THE E. BDY. OF T. 26 N., R. 54 E.

## Chains

From the standard cor. of Tps. 26 N., Rs. 54 and 55 E., heretofore described.

North, along E. bdy. sec. 36.

Over mountainous land, through dense timber and undergrowth; desc. 20 ft. over NW. slope.

2.00 Wash, course N. 60° E.; asc. 115 ft.

9.00 Top of spur, bears SE.; desc. 15 ft. over N. slope.

13.27 Small wash, course SE.; asc. 30 ft.

39.60 Top of spur, bears E. and W.; desc.; leave dense timber, bears E. and W.; and continue thru scattering timber.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a limestone, 2x4x6 ins., mkd. (X), deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 36, with brass cap mkd.

45.40 Wash, course NE.; asc. 110 ft.

48.00 Top of spur, bears NE.; desc. 350 ft. over NW. slope.

79.60 Wash, course N. 85° W.; asc. 45 ft. over SW. slope, with series of limestone outcroppings.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 25 and 36, with brass cap mkd.

Soil, light, shallow, sandy, mixed with decomposed limestone and gravel, with much loose rock on the surface and with many limestone outcroppings.

Timber, pinon and juniper.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and buckbrush.

North, along E. bdy. sec. 25.

Over mountainous land, thru scattering timber and dense undergrowth; asc. 220 ft. over steep SW. slope.
