#### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 42 North, Range 65 E. is situated about 35 miles NE. of Wells, Nevada and about 20 miles SE. of Contact, Nevada. It is entered from U. S. Highway No. 93 at a distance of 32 miles from Wells, Nevada, via the Montello Road.

The terrain, specifically in relation to its value for agriculture and grazing, is of the rolling type, with increasing precipitousness westward from the east boundary; the general drainage is to the southeast.

The soil consists of a light mixture of clay, and decomposed granite and limestone, varying in texture from 2nd to 3d rate.

With the exception of a widely scattering growth of noncommercial juniper, there is no timber within the township. The undergrowth consists of sagebrush, yellowtop and greasewood, with a sparse growth of native grasses.

The average value for grazing is fair.

With the provision of sufficient water agriculture may be carried on; at present there is no water within the last surveyed portion of the township.

There are no settlers within the portion of the township to which these field notes are applicable.
