GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 5 North, Range 66 East is situated mainly in Lake Valley, about 24 miles NNW. of Pioche, Nevada. The east ½ of the township is on a gentle westerly slope, the middle ½ lies on a gentle easterly slope, and the west ½ is situated in the Ely range of mountains. The elevation varies from about 5800 ft. above sea level to about 7000 ft. above sea level. The easterly and westerly drainage within the township runs into Patterson Wash, which drains in a southerly direction through secs. 11, 14, 23, 26 and 35.

The soil is principally of a sandy texture, varying from sandy loam to clay loam in the nearly level regions, and becoming rocky in the hilly areas.
