## Chains

Land, rolling.  
Soil, rocky clay, 3d rate.  
No timber; undergrowth, sagebrush.  
Grazing, fair.

N.0°26'E. on true line bet. secs. 4 and 5.

Desc. slightly over rolling land on a N. slope, through scattering undergrowth.

2.00 Wash, course S.80°E.; asc. 30 ft. over a S. slope.

8.00 Spur, slopes S.80°E.; desc. 10 ft. abruptly.

13.00 Draw, drains SE.; asc. 430 ft. over a S. slope.

21.70 Fence, bears N.59°E. and S.59°W.

31.30 Leave S. slope; continue ascent along an E. slope.

36.69 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. for sec. 5, with brass cap mkd.
