N.0°02'W. on true line bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Asc. 10 ft. over rolling land along an E. slope through scattering undergrowth.

6.00 Spur, slopes S.10°W.; desc. 20 ft. along a W. slope.

20.00 Ridge; bears N.80°W. and S.70°E.; desc. 120 ft. over a N. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with a quart of charcoal deposited at base, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 2, with brass cap mkd.
