

COMPLETING SUBDIVISION OF T. 44 N., R. 32 E.

Chains

North, on sectional guide meridian, bet. secs. 3 and 4.

Desc. 27 ft. over mountainous land, on a NE. slope, thru medium dense undergrowth.

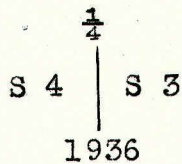
11.30 Wash, drains SE., asc. 14 ft.

15.50 Top of ascent, bears E. and W., desc. 14 ft.

19.50 Wash, drains SE., asc. 95 ft.

38.90 Spur, slopes E., desc. 25 ft. over a NE. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 18 ins. in the ground, to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked



Continue to desc. 50 ft. over a NE. slope.

44.40 Wash, drains E., 5 chs., thence SE., asc. 150 ft.

61.30 Ridge, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W., desc. 120 ft.

72.00 Wash, drains W., asc. 18 ft. over a SW. slope.

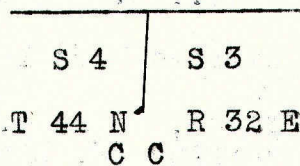
78.20 Spur, slopes W., desc. 60 ft. over a NW. slope.

83.89 Intersect the N. bdy. of the Tp.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4, with brass cap marked

of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor. raise a mound

From point of intersection the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, T. 45 N., R. 32 E., described on page 19, these notes, bears East, 5.68 chs. dist.

From the same point, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 33, only, T. 45 N., R. 32 E., described on page 20, these notes, bears West, 34.32 chs. dist.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky and gravelly, 3d rate.

No timber.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and bunch grass.

Grazing, good.
