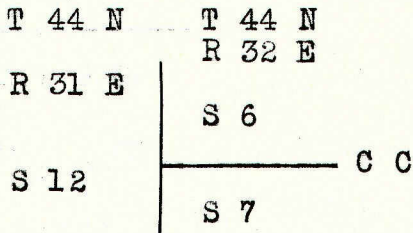


COMPLETING SUBDIVISION OF T. 44 N., R. 32 E.

Chains

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground, to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top, for the closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7, with brass cap marked



1936

Deposit a basalt stone, 6 x 4 x 4 ins., marked with a cross (X) at base of post.

From the point of intersection the cor. of secs. 1 and 12, T. 44 N., R. 31 E., described on page 16, these notes bears N. 0° 58' W., 6.48 chs. dist.

From the same point the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 12, only, T. 44 N., R. 31 E., described on page 15, these notes bears S. 0° 58' E., 34.66 chs. dist.

Land, rolling mountainous.
Soil, rocky and gravelly, 3d rate.
No timber.
Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale, mountain rush and bunch grass.
Grazing, fair.

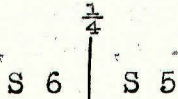
N. 0° 02' W., on true line, bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Desc. 73 ft. over rolling mountainous land, on a NW. slope, thru medium dense undergrowth.

12.80 Wash, drains N. 30° W., desc. 110 ft. over a NW. slope.

32.10 Wash, drains W., asc. 30 ft. over a SW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked



1936

Deposit a porphyry stone, 4 x 4 x 3 ins., marked with a cross (X) at base of post.

Asc. slightly over a SW. slope.

41.00 Spur, slopes W., desc. 20 ft., over a N. slope.

49.40 Head of ravine, drains W., asc. 110 ft. over a S. slope.

72.40 Saddle, bears E. and W., desc. 40 ft. over a NE. slope.

84.33 Intersect the N. bdy. of the Tp.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground, to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top, for the closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd.
