

ESTABLISHMENT OF $\frac{1}{4}$ SEC. CORS.

On the N. bdy. of Sec. 5.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 8 ins. in the ground, to bedrock, with a lava stone, 6x5x4 ins., mkd. X deposited at base and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

The closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, heretofore described, bears West, 39.995 chs. dist.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

T. 45 N., R. 32 E., is located in the mountains West of Kings River about 100 miles North and West of Winnemucca, Nevada. Bilk Creek, a stream of good water flows through a canyon through the East half of the township. This township extends from Bilk Creek east to the top of the canyon and a short way down the slope of the Kings River, drainage to the west, the township extends over the mountain top west of Bilk Creek and across the broken hills drained by the dry channels known as Deep Creek and Texas Springs wash.

Although, apparantly, badly overstocked the area is covered by a fair stand of native grasses, and brush, and has a very good supply of water for stock. Beside Bilk Creek water is obtained from Springs throughout the township as shown on the plat.

There is no settlement in the township and the only improvements consist of troughs at several of the springs.
