Chains

of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, gentle rolling.
Soil, gravelly to rocky loam; 3d rate.
Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale.
Grazing, fair.

West, along the N. bdy. of Sec. 6, on a transit line describing the secant which bears S. 89° 58.5' W.

Over gentle rolling land, thru medium dense undergrowth. Asc. slight E. slope.

39.60 Shallow surface drain, course S. 60° E.

40.00 N. 2 lks. from the secant,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

SUBDIVISION OF T. 28 N., R. 25 E.

I commence the subdivisional survey of T. 28 N., R. 25 E., at the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. of the Tp., which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over rolling land thru medium dense undergrowth.

7.40 Drain, course S. 80° W., asc. over rolling W. slope.

15.10 Drain, course W.

21.80 Dry wash, course W. 2 chs. thence N. 30° W.

27.50 Draw, drains W., asc. along SW. slope.

33.60 Point of rounded spur from the E., desc. along W. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 10 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, with a granite rock, 8x6x2 ins., mkd. X, deposited at the base of post, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
