 Undergrowth, sagebrush, rabbitbrush.

 Grazing, fair.

East, on a random line, bet. secs. 29 and 32.

- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 79.96 Intersect N. and S. line 7 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.
- Thence
- S. $89^{\circ} 57'$ W., on true line bet. secs. 29 and 32.
- Over broken hilly land thru medium dense undergrowth.
- 2.80 Spur, slopes N. 40° W., from this point, a small spring and watering trough bears S. $79^{\circ} 40'$ E., 20 chs. distant. Desc. 100 ft. over NW. slope.
- 10.80 Draw, drains NW., asc. 50 ft. over NE. slope.
- 17.00 Spur, slopes NW., desc. 140 ft. over NW. slope.
- 39.98 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with a deposit of charcoal at the base of post, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

- 79.44 Intersect the W. bdy. of the Tp. 5 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 30 and 31, which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of the survey of T. 28 N., R. 25 E., surveyed under this group.
