

SUBDIVISION OF T. 28 N., R. 26 E.

Chains 80.04	The cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20. Land, rolling. Soil, gravelly and rocky loam; 3d rate. Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale. Grazing, fair.
40.00	S. 89° 57' W., on a random line bet. secs. 18 and 19. Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
79.46	Intersect the W. bdy. of the Tp. at the cor. of secs. 18 and 19, which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 28 N., R. 25 E., surveyed under this group. Thence N. 89° 57' E., on true line bet. secs. 18 and 19. Over gentle rolling land thru medium dense undergrowth.
6.85	Road, bears N. 24° W. and S. 24° E.
11.70	Sandy wash, drains NW., asc. 70 ft. over gentle NW. slope.
39.46	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with a deposit of charcoal at base of post, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd. <div style="text-align: center;">S 18 — S 19 1938</div>
47.00	Main wash, drains N. 20° W., asc. 90 ft. over gentle NW. slope.
79.46	The cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20. Land, rolling. Soil, sandy to coarse gravelly loam; 2nd and 3d rate. Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale, rabbitbrush. Grazing, fair.
15.00	N. 0° 04' W., bet. secs. 17 and 18. Over rolling land thru medium dense undergrowth. Shallow draw, drains NW.
40.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd. <div style="text-align: center;">$\frac{1}{4}$ S18 S17 1938</div> raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.
45.00	Draw, drains N. 20° W.
48.20	Draw, drains NW.
79.70	Shallow surface drain, course NW.
80.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground,
