GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The lands of this township vary from nearly level rolling plains on the extreme eastern and western edges to rough rocky mountainous areas in the central portion. The elevation varies from about 7400 feet in sections 28 and 33 to about 4200 ft. in sections 12 and 13.

There is no commercial growth of timber in the township; all slopes have a fairly dense covering of small desert type undergrowth with sagebrush, shadscale and rabbitbrush predominating. Good grasses are found on the higher slopes and afford fair stock grazing uses for the lands. Springs, suitable for stock watering purposes after some additional development and construction of adequate troughs, are situated in the following subdivisions:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25 (Cottonwood Spring & troughs.)

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25 (Small seepage spring) North Cottonwood Spring.)

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 27 (Small hillside spring)

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 34 (Small seepage spring.)

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 32 (Juniper Spring and troughs.)

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 33 (Small hillside spring & trough.)

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 33 (Small spring & trough.)
