	raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor. From this cor. the stan. cor. of secs. 31 and 32, T. 31 N., R. 26 E., which is monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the Independent Resurvey of the 6th.
