General Description

The south boundary of T. 30 N., R. 27 E., M.D.M. traverses a rolling valley west of the Seven Trough Range and crosses a low divide at the south end of the mountain range known as The Lava Beds. The area is approximately 30 miles northwest of Lovelock, Nevada and from 6 to 12 miles west of the mining camp of Vernon. The land is typical gently rolling desert and low rolling desert hills, ranging in elevation from 3800 ft. to 4700 ft. covered with a low sparse growth of brush. There is no water, no habitation, no improvements and no improved roads in the immediate vicinity.
