Survey commenced October 20, 1938. For description and test of instruments and meridians from which the true bearings of the final surveyed lines were derived, refer to the field notes of the survey of T. 28 N., R. 26 E., M.D.Mer., Nevada, executed under Group No. 209 Nevada during the same surveying season.

SURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY OF TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 26 EAST.


I commence at the cor. of Ts. 28 and 29 N., Rs. 26 and 27 E., which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of the survey of T. 28 N., R. 26 E., executed under Group No. 209 Nevada. The true azimuth at this point is developed from a meridian previously determined at the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, two miles south.

Thence

North, bet. secs. 31 and 36,


Over rough mountainous land thru medium dense undergrowth.

- .10 Rocky ravine, course E., asc. 350 ft. over rocky S. slope.
- 12.40 Spur, slopes S.60°E., desc. 150 ft. over rocky S. slope.
- 20.80 Ravine, course S.60°E., asc. 200 ft. over abrupt, rocky S. slope.
- 30.30 Spur ridge, bears NE. and SW., desc. 200 ft. over broken, rocky NW. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to solid rock, with a basalt rock, 6x4x2 ins., mkd X deposited at base of post, and in a large mound of stone to top of post, for 1/4 sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.



Desc. 185 ft. over broken NW. slope.

- 52.20 Draw, drains S.60°W., asc. 230 ft. over broken S. slope along top of rocky spur from the N.
- 65.70 Rocky spur, slopes SW. and S. from the NW., desc. 140 ft. over a general E. slope.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, with brass cap mkd.
