

Subdivision of T. 29 N., R. 27 E.

Chains

Asc. gradually 50 ft. over a NE. slope.

47.00 N. end of an isolated low spur, projects S.; desc. 65 ft. over NW. slope.

51.50 Slope changes to a W. slope.

53.90 Base of slope; thence desc. slightly over a SW. slope.

66.80 A graded dirt road, bears NW. and SE.

71.00 Wash, 10 lks. wide, course S. 20° W.

80.04 The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11, and 12.

Land, rolling and hilly.

Soil, sandy, gravelly and rocky; 4th rate.

No timber; undergrowth, shadscale, sage and desert brush.

N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 1 and 2.

Over a gentle broken rolling SW. slope, through dense undergrowth; asc. 60 ft. to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

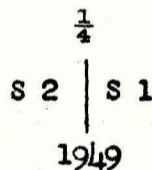
19.50 A graded dirt road, bears NW. and SE.

28.50 Wash, 5 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course SW.

39.20 A brushy wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course SW.

40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Asc. gradually over a gentle SW. slope 75 ft. to N. bdy.

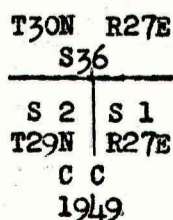
60.50 A brushy wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course SW.

75.50 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course SW.

78.44 Intersect the South Boundary of T. 30 N., R. 27 E.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, T. 29 N., R. 27 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.
