

Chains 23.40	Channel of wash, 2.00 chs. wide, with gravel bottom, course N. 10° W.; thence across a broken gentle NNE. slope; ascend slightly.
40.00	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 7. Land, rolling and broken hills. Soil, sandy, gravelly and rocky; 4th rate. No timber; undergrowth, sage, shadscale and desert brush.

34.00	Begin gradual descent of N. slope, 25 ft.
40.00	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6. 78.30	Intersect the South Boundary of T. 30 N., R. 27 E.  Point for the closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, T. 29 N., R. 27 E.
