

Resurvey, Subdivision of T. 40 N., R. 27 E.

Chains

stone monument buried in the mound.

From this corner a hub and lath at high water mark on left wing of proposed damsite in Battle Creek, bears S.27°E., 13.30 chs. dist.

North, bet. secs. 3 and 4. (N $\frac{1}{2}$ mile)

Ascend 200 ft. on SE. slope, thru very light vegetation.

5.15 Local road, bears E. to Battle Creek Ranch and W. about .3 mile to end.

23.30 Old mine road, bears S.75°E. and NW., in ravine, course S.75°E.; ascend 240 ft. over granite boulders on SW. slope of hills.

36.90 Intersect the Eighth Standard Parallel North.

Point for closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a flat mound of stone, 3 ft. base, around post to top.

From point of intersection the stan. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, T.41 N., R.27 E., bears east, 16.02 chs. dist.

Land, rolling valley and rough mountainous.
Soil, alkaline clayloam, 2d rate; rocky, 4th rate.
Undergrowth, sagebrush and shadscale.

At midpoint on the N. bdy. of sec. 3.

Point for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 3.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Dig a circular trench, 5 ft. diam., and raise a flat mound of stone, 2 ft. base, around post.

From this point the stan. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., S. bdy. of sec. 34, T.41 N., R.27 E., bears east, 14.86 chs. dist.
