From the point of intersection the standard corner of secs. 33 and 34, T. 16 S., R. 64 E., bears West, 14.19 chs. dist.; an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the Fourth Standard Parallel South, executed under this group.

From the same point, the standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., S. bdy. of sec. 34, T. 16 S., R. 64 E., bears East, 25.81 chs. dist.; an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the Fourth Standard Parallel South, executed under this group.

Land, rolling desert hills.

Soil, sandy, rocky in places; 3rd rate.

Timber, none.

Undergrowth, black brush, buck brush, creosote brush and cactus.

Grazing, poor.

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set; marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 18 S., R. 64 E., resurveyed under this group,

N.0°02'W., bet. secs. 33 and 34.

Over rolling foothills, through scattering undergrowth; descend 70 ft. over gentle northerly slope.

17.30 Small wash, course E.; ascend 10 ft. over SE. slope.

25.70 Top of ascent, slopes E.; descend 30 ft. over NE. slope.

34.10 Small wash, course E.; ascend 15 ft. over SE. slope.

38.00 Top of ascent, slopes E.; thence along a general E. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to solid rock, with a limestone, 6x6x5 ins., marked X; deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top of post, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

40.10 Head of small wash, course N.80°E.; ascend over SE. slope.

48.00 Top of ascent, slopes N.60°E.; descend over N. slope.

56.00 Small wash, course NE.; thence along E. slope.

60.90 Small wash, course E.; ascend 40 ft. over southerly slope.

74.00 Top of ascent, slopes SE.; descend 15 ft. along an E. slope.

79.00 Small wash, course SE.; ascend over southerly slope.
