Chains

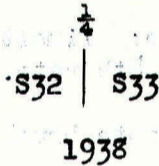
Land, gently rolling desert; general drainage and exposure W.
 Soil, sandy; 2nd and 3rd rate.
 Timber, none.
 Undergrowth, creosote brush, black brush, buck brush, shadscale and cactus.
 Grazing, poor.

From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, on the S. bdy. of Tp., which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 18 S., R. 64 E., resurveyed under this group,

N.0°03'W., bet. secs. 32 and 33.

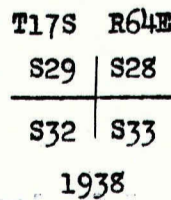
Over rolling desert land, through scattering undergrowth, along a general W. slope.

- 24.50 Small wash, course W.
- 36.00 Small spur, slopes N.80°W.
- 39.00 Small wash, course N.70°W.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

- 49.30 Small spur, slopes N.70°W.
- 62.10 Small wash, course N.70°W.
- 80.00 In small wash, course N.70°W.,
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33, with brass cap mkd.

- 79.96 Intersect N. and S. line, 2 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.
