Chains	<p>Independent Resurvey superseding the survey executed by W. H. Myrick, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1882.</p> <p>From the stan. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of T. 20 S., R. 65 E., which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.</p> <p>Thence</p> <p>N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.</p> <p>Over broken desert hills, through scattering undergrowth, ascend 200 ft. over broken SW. slope.</p> <p>13.20 Spur, slopes S. 70° W.; thence along W. slope.</p> <p>17.00 Slope changes, descend 280 ft. over steep NW. slope.</p> <p>25.50 Enter wash, course S. 60° W.</p> <p>28.90 Leave wash; ascend 270 ft. over S. slope.</p> <p>40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., on solid surface rock, with a granite stone, 8x6x6 ins., marked X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>$\frac{1}{4}$</div><div>S35 S36</div><div>1938</div></div> <p>Ascend 150 ft. over S. slope.</p> <p>47.30 Sharp topped rocky spur, slopes S. 60° W.; thence along W. slope.</p> <p>48.80 Spur, slopes N. 80° W.; descend 280 ft. over N. slope.</p> <p>57.70 Wash, 15 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course N. 70° W.; ascend 125 ft. over broken SW. slope.</p> <p>67.40 Spur, slopes N. 50° W.; descend 20 ft. over general NW. slope.</p> <p>75.40 Small wash, course S. 80° W.; ascend 100 ft. over SE. slope.</p> <p>80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to solid rock, with a granite stone, 5x4x4 ins., marked X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top; for the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35, and 36, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>T20S R65E</div><div>S26 S25</div><div>S35 S36</div><div>1938</div></div> <p>Land, rocky broken desert hills; general drainage and exposure SW.</p> <p>Soil, rocky clay loam; 4th rate.</p> <p>Timber, none.</p> <p>Undergrowth, creosote brush, mountain rush, and cactus.</p> <p>Grazing, poor.</p>
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
