

Traverse of the Colorado River through a portion of  
T. 32 S., R. 66 E., M. D. M.

N. 5° 57' E., 8.87 chs. At 7.00 leave area being developed.  
At end of course, point for the meander  
corner of fractional secs. 12 and 13,  
which is 0.90 chs. East of the witness  
corner monument.

Land, level.

Soil, sandy and clayey silt; 2nd rate.

Timber, scattering mesquite and willow.

Undergrowth, arrow weed, scrub mesquite and willow brush.

Grazing, poor.

From point for the meander corner of fractional secs. 1 and 12,  
which is 0.90 chs. East of the witness corner monument.

Thence up stream along the right bank of the river in sec. 1.

Along top of bank 10 to 12 ft. high at the East side of a gravel  
road, through the construction camp or town of Davis Dam, Nevada.

N. 2° 30' W., 10.00 chs. At end of course, temporary bridge across  
the river; thence along top of bank at  
East side of a row of buildings.

N. 4° 00' W., 8.70 chs. At end of course, end of row of buildings  
and leave town.

N. 7° 00' W., 4.00 chs. Thence along bank 10 to 15 ft. high at  
East side of gravel road.

N. 9° 15' W., 5.10 chs.

N. 18° 15' W., 5.70 chs.

N. 26° 00' W., 7.00 chs.

N. 43° 00' W., 3.30 chs. At end of course, temporary bridge across  
the river.

N. 15° 00' E., 2.50 chs.

N. 19° 00' E., 1.00 chs.

N. 15° 00' W., 5.00 chs.

N. 17° 00' W., 5.00 chs. At end of course, leave canyon.

N. 1° 45' W., 25.02 chs. At 4.00 chs., mouth of wash from west.  
At 13.00 chs. Road bears West, and East  
over temporary bridge across the river.  
At end of course, point for the meander  
corner of fractional secs. 1 and 36,  
which is 32.34 chs. East of the corner  
of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36.

Land, nearly level bottom of canyon and level bottom land.

Soil, sandy silt, 2nd rate and rocky, 4th rate.

Timber, few scattered mesquite at river bank.

Undergrowth, scrub mesquite, willow brush and arrow weed.

Grazing, poor.

#### General Description

The land within the dependently resurveyed portion of T. 32 S.,  
R. 66 E., M. D. M., is located along the Colorado River from 8 to  
14 miles north of the southern extremity of the State of Nevada.
