

Dependent Resurvey of the Subdivision of T. 32 N., R. 66 E.

Reestablishment of the surveys executed by
Smyles and Preble, Deputy Surveyors, in 1881.

Beginning at the reestablished cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set and mkd. as described in the field notes of the exteriors resurveyed under this group.

N. 0° 27' E., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over nearly level land, through dense desert undergrowth.

39.95 Proportionate point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with broken glass deposited at base, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

79.91 Proportionate point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with broken glass deposited at base, for cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, alluvial light sandy loam and adobe alkali; 4th rate.

Timber, none; undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale, greasewood and scant grass.

From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set and mkd. as described in the field notes of the exteriors resurveyed under this group.

N. 88° 51' W., bet. secs. 25 and 36.

Over nearly level land, through dense undergrowth.

40.08 Proportionate point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with broken glass deposited at base, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
