

T. 2 S., R. 70 E.

General Description

The south boundary of T. 2 S., R. 70 E. traverses a rolling to broken mountainous area. Most of the area of the township is covered with a scattering to dense stand of juniper, pinon pine and scrub oak timber, with scattering to dense growth of sage, service, oak and buck brush. Elevations over the township are generally above the 6,000 foot contour level.

Nevada State Highway No. 25, leading from Panaca, Nevada to Modena, Utah, crosses the extreme southern portion of the township, bearing generally west northwest and east southeast.
