General Description

The land in the portion of the township being surveyed is in general a broken, gravelly bench. A small portion in the southeast corner reaches up onto the west side of a high mountain range. The drainage is southeast into White River Canyon in the eastern part of the area. This is a dry wash and in places, notably in the cultivated area in sections 24 and 25, the channel is obliterated. The soil is a poor, gravelly clay loam. There is no timber in the township, and the undergrowth consists of sagebrush, rabbit and buck brush, weeds and sparse grass. There is no living water in the township, but a well has been drilled in section 24 to provide irrigation water for the cultivated land in sections 24 and 25. There are no inhabitants in the area. No commercial deposits of minerals were encountered.
