

## Independent Resurvey of the East Boundary of T. 5 S., R. 61 E.

Chains	
	Beginning at the cor. of Ts. 5 and 6 S., R. 61 E., which is monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the survey of the east boundary of T. 6 S., R. 61 E., executed concurrently under this same survey group.
	Note: No original corners were found along this boundary.
	North, along the E. bdy. of sec. 36, T. 5 S., R. 61 E.
	Over a rolling SW. slope, strewn with numerous volcanic boulders, through scattered timber and undergrowth; asc. 70 ft. to ridge.
10.70	Low flat divide ridge, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 35 ft. over rolling N. slope.
26.00	Change to rolling NW. slope; desc. 75 ft. over same.
29.10	Shallow wash, 70 lks. wide, drains N. 60° W.; asc. 35 ft. over SW. slope.
33.10	Low spur, slopes W.; desc. 100 ft. over NW. slope.
40.00	Point for the E. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 36, falls on N. edge of a rock shelf, 8 ft. high, in unsafe, impractical place for corner. I chisel an "X" in the rock, marking the true corner point.
40.02	A safe place for reference monument at N. base of rock ledge.
	Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and supported in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.

	No auxiliary accessory.
	Desc. 70 ft. over NW. slope.
44.20	Small side ravine, drains NW.; asc. 55 ft. over SW. slope.
47.20	Small spur, slopes N. 60° W.; desc. 75 ft. over N. slope.
50.30	Shallow wash, 30 lks. wide, in steep ravine, drains N. 80° W.; asc. 50 ft. over S. slope.
55.70	Small spur, slopes W.; desc. 60 ft. over NW. slope.
58.30	Wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains W.; thence along foot of W. slope.
63.80	Wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains S. 60° W.; asc. 125 ft. over SW. slope.
71.70	Spur, slopes W. from S. 70° E.; desc. 75 ft. over NW. slope.
80.00	Point for the cor. of secs. 25 and 36.
