

Dependent Resurvey of the East Boundary of T. 7 S., R. 61 E.

Chains

Bury the old corner stone alongside and raise a supporting mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 20 ins. high, around the iron post.

From this corner, a prominent rock outcrop, known locally as White Hill, rising 120 ft. above corner, bears S. 76° W., approximately 6.00 chs. dist.

Land, rolling, desert hills.

Soil, sandy to gravelly clay loam.

Timber, none; undergrowth, sagebrush, rabbit brush, greasewood, and cacti.

N. 0° 30' E., along the E. bdy. of sec. 1.

Over rolling mountainous land, through scattered undergrowth; asc. 20 ft. over SE. slope.

1.00 Ridge, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 165 ft. over NW. and along W. slopes.

24.30 Swale at head of gulch, which drains S. 70° W.; asc. 100 ft. over S. slope.

35.00 Spur, slopes SW.; asc. 90 ft. along W. slope.

40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at record distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

As this corner will no longer serve for sec. 6, I now remonument it to refer to sec. 1 only, as follows

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., over an X marked on barren rock outcrop, and in a supporting mound of stone, 5 ft. base, 30 ins. high, with brass cap mkd.

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No auxiliary accessory.

Desc. 40 ft. over NW. slope.

41.30 Gully, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains N. 80° W.; asc. 110 ft. over SW. slope.

58.00 Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 25 ft. along W. slope.

62.00 Gully, 25 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains generally to the W.; asc. 325 ft. over S. and SW. slopes to township corner.

80.00 Record distance from nearest original corners to S. and W. for cor. of Ts. 6 and 7 S., Rs. 61 and 62 E.; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

As this corner will no longer serve for Ts. 6 and 7 S., R. 62 E., I now reestablish it for Ts. 6 and 7 S., R. 61 E. only, as follows

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 15 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with brass cap mkd.
