

## Dependent Resurvey of the East Boundary of T. 8 S., R. 61 E.

Chains

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with brass cap mkd.

Bury the old corner stone alongside and raise a supporting mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 24 ins. high, around the iron post.

No auxiliary accessory.

N. 0° 56' E., beginning new measurement.

Asc. 80 ft. over rather abrupt, boulder-strewn S. slope.

4.00 Change to W. slope; asc. 80 ft. along same.

24.00 Crest of ascent, bears E. and W.; desc. 75 ft. over NE. slope.

34.00 Wash, 150 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains SE.; asc. 50 ft. over SW. slope.

39.70 The original cor. of Ts. 7 and 8 S., Rs. 61 and 62 E., which is monumented with a trachyte stone, 12x12x10 ins., firmly set in a mound of earth and stone, and marked with 6 grooves on E., S., W. and N. faces.

This corner will no longer serve for Ts. 7 and 8 S., R. 62 E., and is now remonumented to refer to Ts. 7 and 8 S., R. 61 E. only, as follows

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with brass cap mkd.

Timber, scattered Joshua trees and yucca trees; undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood, and cacti.

North, bet. secs. 31 and 36, Ts. 8 S., Rs. 62 and 63 E.
