From this corner, the original standard closing cor. for SW. cor. of sec. 31, T. 8 S., R. 63 E., which was established North, 2.09 chs. dist. from the SE. cor. of sec. 36, T. 8 S., R. 62 E., and which I find monumented with a granite stone, 6x8x16 ins., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, bears N. 57° 35' W., 3.86 chs. dist. I remove the old corner stone and bury it alongside the above iron post, and destroy all visible evidence of the old corner position and its accessories. Also from the above iron post corner, the original standard cor. for SE. cor. of sec. 36, T. 8 N., R. 62 E., bears N. 89° 59' W., 3.21 chs. dist., described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of a portion of the S. bdy. of T. 8 S., R. 62 E. Land, mountainous. Soil, clay, gravel, and rock. Timber, scattered juniper and Joshua trees; undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood, and cacti. |
