<p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>Most of the area included in this survey in T. 20 S., R. 60 E. is nearly level desert valley, with drainage generally to the east. The soil is nearly all sandy to gravelly clay loam. The area is cut by numerous washes that usually do not continue any great distance, but terminate in flat, alluvial fans.</p> <p>An isolated hill covering about 100 acres is situated on the west boundary of sec. 6. This hill reaches an elevation of about 625 ft. above the surrounding desert valley floor, and slopes quite steeply in all directions from its highest point down to the desert floor level.</p> <p>The area is highly criss-crossed with unimproved rut roads.</p> <p>A recently constructed power line crosses the area, entering the township near the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32 on the N. bdy. and running SE., near the cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16, thence S., near the cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, thence SW., leaving the area covered by this survey near the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.</p> <p>The entire area appears to be admirably sutiable for small tract homesites. Sand and gravel is also a valuable product existing here in abundance.</p> <p>Vegetation is generally sparse and consists mainly of yucca and creosote bush, with some cactus, ironwood and greasewood.</p>
