X, at base of iron post.</div> <div>Land, rolling for first half-mile; rough for second half-mile.</div> <div>Soil, rocky and gravelly.</div> <div>Vegetation, scattered creosote bush, salt brush and cactus.</div>
19.44	<div>S. 88° 02' W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.</div> <div>Descend over steep, rough, broken land, through scattered undergrowth.</div> <div>Point for the E. 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at proportionate distance; on steep descent.</div> <div>Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.</div> <div><div>E 1/16</div><div><div>S 31</div><div>S 6</div></div><div>1955</div></div>
32.95	<div>Base of steep descent; ledges bear N. and S.</div>
38.88	<div>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</div> <div>Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.</div> <div><div>¼</div><div><div>S 31</div><div>S 6</div></div><div>1955</div></div>
41.00	<div>Thence ascend E. slope, base of slope bears N. and S.</div>
43.20	<div>Top of ascent, bears N. and S.; descend over W. slope.</div>

58.32	<div>Point for the W. 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at proportionate distance.</div> <div>Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground with brass cap mkd.</div> <div><div>W 1/16</div><div><div>S 31</div><div>S 6</div></div><div>1955</div></div> <div>Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 3 ft. high, N. of cor.</div>
70.30	<div>Top of ascent, bears N. and S.; descend over W. slope.</div>
76.56	<div>Point for the cor. of Ts. 22 and 23 S., Rs. 59 and 60 E., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</div> <div>Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.</div>
