

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY, T. 22 S., R. 60 E.

Chains

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{T 22 S} \quad \text{R 60 E} \\ \hline \text{S 31} \quad | \quad \text{S 32} \\ \hline \text{S 6} \quad | \quad \text{S 5} \\ \hline \text{T 23 S} \\ 1955 \end{array}$$

Bury witness rock, 6 x 6 x 2 ins., mkd. X, at base of iron post.

Land, rolling for first half-mile; rough for second half-mile.
Soil, rocky and gravelly.

Vegetation, scattered creosote bush, salt brush and cactus.

S. 88° 02' W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Descend over steep, rough, broken land, through scattered undergrowth.

19.44 Point for the E. 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at proportionate distance; on steep descent.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{E 1/16} \quad \text{S 31} \\ \hline \text{S 6} \\ 1955 \end{array}$$

32.95 Base of steep descent; ledges bear N. and S.

38.88 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.

$$\begin{array}{r} \frac{1}{4} \quad \text{S 31} \\ \hline \text{S 6} \\ 1955 \end{array}$$

41.00 Thence ascend E. slope, base of slope bears N. and S.

43.20 Top of ascent, bears N. and S.; descend over W. slope.

53.10 Base of descent, bears N. and S.; ascend E. slope.

58.32 Point for the W. 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at proportionate distance.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground with brass cap mkd.

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{W 1/16} \quad \text{S 31} \\ \hline \text{S 6} \\ 1955 \end{array}$$

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 3 ft. high, N. of cor.

70.30 Top of ascent, bears N. and S.; descend over W. slope.

76.56 Point for the cor. of Ts. 22 and 23 S., Rs. 59 and 60 E., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
