

## Dependent Resurvey of the East Boundary of T. 42 N., R. 37 E.

## Chains

40.12

Point for the E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 1, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

From this cor., the closing cor. of Ts. 42 and 43 N., R. 38 E., bears N.  $0^{\circ} 24'$  E., 5.56 chs. dist., and is monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

Land, rolling mountainous.

Soil, sandy clay loam with stony exposure.

Vegetation, scattering sagebrush; no timber.

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by

From the cor. of Ts. 41 and 42 N., Rs. 36 and 37 E., marked by an iron post,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 41 N., R. 37 E., executed concurrently in 1954 under Group 359, Nevada.

N.  $0^{\circ} 32'$  E., bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over nearly level land.

Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Bury an igneous stone, 6x4x3 ins., mkd. X, alongside the iron post.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
