

Dependent Resurvey of the West Boundary of T. 42 N., R. 37 E.

Chains

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Bury an igneous stone, 6x4x2 ins., mkd. X, alongside the iron post.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, alkaline clay-loam.

Vegetation, sagebrush, salt sage and greasewood; no timber.

N. $0^{\circ} 22'$ E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over nearly level land.

39.84 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Bury an igneous stone, 5x5x2 ins., mkd. X, alongside the iron post.

79.68 Point for the cor. of Ts. 42 and 43 N., Rs. 36 and 37 E., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Bury an igneous stone, 5x4x2 ins. mkd. X, alongside the iron post.

From this point the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, T. 43 N., Rs. 36 and 37 E., an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey of a portion of the E. bdy. of T. 43 N., R. 36 E., executed concurrently in 1954, bears N. $0^{\circ} 32'$ W., 159.36 chains. dist.

From the same point, the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 34, Ts. 42 and 43 N., R. 36 E., now marked by an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the resurvey field notes of a portion of the south boundary of T. 43 N., R. 36 E., executed concurrently in 1954, bears N. $89^{\circ} 41'$ W., 200.30 chs. dist.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, alkaline clay-loam.

Vegetation, greasewood, salt sage and salt grass; no timber.
