- Deposit broken glass alongside the iron post, 12 ins. below the surface of the ground.
- 40.03 Fence, five strand barbed wire on cedar posts, bears W. and E. 60 lks. dist.; thence S.
- 44.75 Irrigation ditch, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, bears NE. and SW. Water flows SW.
- 57.00 Road, bears NW. and SE.
- 63.00 Graded, graveled road, bears N. $43^{\circ} 45'$ W. and S. $43^{\circ} 45'$ E.
- 63.20 Telephone line, bears N. $43^{\circ} 45'$ W. and S. $43^{\circ} 45'$ E.
- 79.86 Intersect the north boundary of the township at the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, and 32, which is monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, hereinbefore described.
- Land, nearly level.
Soil, sandy loam.
No timber.
Undergrowth, sagebrush and greasewood.

General Description

The general elevation of the township ranges from approximately 4500 ft. above sea level at the corner of secs. 25 and 36 on the east boundary to approximately 3000 ft. in the western portion.

The land is rough, mountainous and stony in the eastern half of secs. 25 and 36, gently rolling for approximately $\frac{1}{3}$ of the eastern portion of the township, and the remainder is nearly level land. All the drainage in the township is to the west with low spurs which are indefinite. The soil in the eastern half of the township is sandy and gravelly loam and sandy loam with some alkaline spots in the western half of the township.

Rebel Creek enters the township near the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 13 on the east boundary of the township and flows in a west and northwesterly direction through secs. 13, 14, 15, 10, and 9. Rock Creek enters near the southeast corner of the township and flows in a westerly direction through secs. 36, 35, 34. These streams only flow for a short period during the early spring months and are dry the remainder of the year.

U. S. Highway No. 95 traverses through the township entering near the corner of secs. 2, 3, 34, and 35 on the south boundary and leaving at the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 35 on the north boundary. Nevada State Highway No. 8A, a graded, gravelled road, starts at the Orovada, Nevada, store and post office and traverses west and northwest and leaves the township near the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 24. There are numerous other graded, gravelled access roads in the west and north central portion of the township.
