

Dependent Resurvey of the E. Bdy., T. 45 N., R. 36 E.

Chains

- 29.31 Slope changes to NE. slope; desc. 60 ft. into ravine.
- 37.25 Wash, 4 lks. wide, 1½ ft. deep, drains southeasterly; asc. S. slope 40 ft.
- 39.47 The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, which is monumented by a volcanic stone, 20x14x4 ins., mkd., set and witnessed as described in the official record. This corner now serves for secs. 1 and 12, T 45 N., R. 36 E. only.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

- Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 20 ins. high, W. of cor.
- Reset original stone at base of post.
- Land, steep southerly slopes.
Soil, sandy loam.
Timber, none; undergrowth, sagebrush.
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- N. 0° 02' W., along the E. bdy. of sec. 1.
- 0.88 Point for the closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7, T. 45 N., R. 37 E., hereinafter described; asc. 270 ft. up steep S. slope, through moderate undergrowth.
- 18.15 Slope changes to SW. slope; asc. 150 ft.
- 27.35 Base of volcanic ledge, bears N. 45° W. and S. 45° E.; asc. 30 ft. to top; continue to asc. SW. slope; asc. 80 ft.
- 37.59 Base of volcanic ledge, bears N. and S., ledge about 40 ft. high and E. of line, along steep W. slope.
- 39.93 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate dist.; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. This corner now serves for sec. 1, T. 45 N., R. 36 E., only.
- Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

- 40.88 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 6, T. 45 N., R. 37 E., hereinafter described; desc. 640 ft. along steep, rocky W. slope, through moderate undergrowth.
- 81.06 The closing cor. of T. 45 N., Rs. 36 and 37 E., which is mkd. by a volcanic stone, 24x12x4 ins., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, and rebuild old mound of stone, 5 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
