Palmer in 1868 and 1869.</p> <p>Beginning at the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of T. 45 N., R. 38 E., which is monumented by an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set and mkd. as described in the official record.</p> <p>East, along the S. bdy. of sec. 34.</p> <p>Over nearly level ground, through meadow land.</p>
0.15	Fence, bears N. 23° W. and S. 23° E.
4.13	The closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4, T. 44 N., R. 38 E., which is monumented by an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set and mkd. as described in the official record.
11.40	Ditch, 20 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, course N. 30° W.
11.70	Flat Creek, 25 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course N. 20° E.
14.10	Fence, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W.
16.55	Fence, bears N. and S.; asc. 200 ft. over W. slope, through sagebrush.
