Bury the original corner stone alongside the iron post.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, gravelly.

Undergrowth, sagebrush.

N. 89° 51' E., along the S. bdy. of sec. 36.

Desc. 45 ft. over rolling land, through light sagebrush.

6.40 The closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, T. 44 N., R. 38 E., monumented by an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set and mkd. as described in the official record.

Asc. 190 ft. over W. slope.

27.20 Spur, bears N. and S.; desc. 35 ft. over E. slope.

29.65 Asc. 20 ft. over W. slope.

37.16 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, monumented by an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set and mkd. as described in the official record.

N. 89° 40' E., beginning new measurement.

Asc. 60 ft. over W. slope.

6.15 Spur, bears N. and S.; desc. 80 ft. over E. slope.

9.45 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1, T. 44 N., R. 38 E., at midpoint on the N. bdy. of sec. 1; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Asc. 60 ft. over W. slope.

24.95 Fence, bears N. 75° E. and S. 75° W.

28.60 Spur, bears NW.; desc. gradually over NE. slope.

37.06 True point for the cor. of T. 45 N., Rs. 38 and 39 E., falls in a deep wash draining NW.; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.

37.42 Point for the witness cor., at a safe place for the cor. on the E. bank of wash.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Bury the original corner stone alongside the iron post.

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

From this point, the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 6, Ts. 44 N., Rs. 38 and 39 E., monumented by a porphyry stone, 12x10x8 ins., firmly set and mkd. with 6 grooves on S. and W. faces, bears N. 89° 40' E., 12.24 chs. dist.
