27.57 Bottom of canyon; creek drains W.

28.86 Asc. 15 ft. to unimproved road, which bears E. and W.; thence asc. 50 ft. over S. slope.

39.88 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 46 N., R. 39 E., at midpoint on W. bdy. of sec. 31.
