General Description	
The land within T. 46 N., R. 38 E., is level to nearly level in the west portion, with rolling hills in the east portion, the foothills on the east boundary being the roughest, with a western exposure. The drainage is generally northwest toward the Quinn River, which drains Southwest through sections 5, 6 and 7. The valley elevation is about 4500 ft. above sea level, with the hills along the east boundary ranging from 100 to 400 ft. higher.
