Chains

	From the N 1/16 cor. of secs. 1 and 6, on the E. bdy. of the Tp.
	N. 89° 41' W., on the E. and W. center line of the NE ¼ of sec. 1.
9.00	Road, bears N. and SW.

General Description

The land in this section is nearly level. The general elevation is approximately 6300 ft. and slopes gradually in a NNW. direction. The soil is a sandy and gravelly loam.

U. S. Highway Nos. 50 and 93 enters the section near the N 1/16 cor. of secs. 1 and 2 and traverses in a northeast direction, leaving near the W 1/16 cor. of secs. 1 and 36. There is one graded, gravelled road that enters the section near the N 1/16 cor. of secs. 1 and 6 and traverses in a northwest direction through the northeast quarter, thence in a southwest direction through the northwest quarter, leaving near the N 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2 to a junction with U. S. Highway Nos. 50 and 93.

Steptoe Creek enters the section about midpoint between the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 12 and the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, and flows in a general northwest direction, leaving near the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2.

There is scattered sagebrush throughout the section with a fair stand of native grasses, which flourishes except during periods of drouth.

There is no cultivated land within the section and, at the present time, there are no settlers.
