General Description

The south boundary of T. 19 S., R. 58 E., falls along the north side of La Madre Mountain, crossing numerous washes and spurs, but staying at a general elevation of about 5200 ft. above sea level.

The soil is a rocky clay; the vegetation consists of buck brush, blackbrush, sparse grass and scattered pinon and juniper.

There are three access roads crossing the boundary, one each on the south boundary of sections 31, 32 and 33.
