Undergrowth; yucca, creosote bush, rabbit brush, cactus, etc.</div>
	<div>From the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12 on the E. bdy. of the town-ship, which is monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of T. 20 S., R. 60 E., executed concurrently but under Group 357.</div> <div>S. 87° 16' W., bet. secs. 1 and 12.</div> <div>Asc. over gradual SE. slope, through scattered yucca and creosote for entire mile.</div> <div>1.90 Wash, 50 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains S. 30° E.</div> <div>21.25 Point for the E. 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 12, at proportionate dist.</div> <div>Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</div> <div><div>T20S R59E</div><div>E1/16 — S1</div><div>S12</div><div>1957</div></div> <div>42.50<div>Raise a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.</div><div>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 12, at proportionate dist.; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.</div><div>Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</div><div><div>T20S R59E</div><div>¼ — S1</div><div>S12</div><div>1957</div></div><div>Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor.</div></div>
