Chains

From this same cor. the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 8 and 17, which is monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set in the ground, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, bears S. $89^{\circ} 30'$ E., 40.26 chs. dist.

From this same cor. the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 17 and 18, which is monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set in the ground, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, bears S. $3^{\circ} 07'$ E., 40.03 chs. dist.

S. $89^{\circ} 00'$ W., bet. secs. 7 and 18.

Over nearly level land, along the center line of a graded gravel road.

8.00 Leave road; road bears N. 89° E. and S. 45° W.

12.00 Enter gravel pit, edge bears NW. and SW.

30.70 Leave gravel pit, edge bears N. and SE.

33.00 Enter road, bears SE. and S. 89° W.

40.21 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 18, at proportionate distance near center of graded road; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 8 ins. below the surface of the ground, with brass cap mkd.

An iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set 24 ins. in the ground for a reference monument, bears S. $55^{\circ} 39'$ W., 1.091 chs. dist., with brass cap mkd. T22S R61E S18 RM 72 Ft. 1956 and an arrow pointing to the true cor.

70.00 Wash, 10 lks. wide, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. deep, drains SE.

78.45 Road, bears N. and S. and N. 89° E.

78.54 Intersect W. bdy. of Tp. at the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, which is monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.
